



EPPA Scribe Common FAQ's

1. How do I apply?
 - a. Complete and submit application to scribeapplicant@emer-phys.com
2. Does this position qualify for PA clinical contact hours?
 - a. Physician Assistant Contact hours-: Scribe hours may count towards entry requirements. (This is individual program specific, please verify for yourself)
3. Do I get to touch patients or provide direct patient care?
 - a. No. No patient contact is allowed. Scribes are not allowed to perform clinical tasks, handle body fluids, provide medical advice or interpretation
4. Can I work over the summer?
 - a. No. This is not an internship and our hope is to retain our scribe employees as long as possible. The overall on-boarding process takes up to 8 weeks. Therefore, this would limit your experience and ability to truly learn. The value of scribing exponentially rises with the more experience you get, so limiting the exposure to only a few months creates not only scheduling and operational issues, but mainly inhibits the scribe's ability to truly learn.
5. Do scribes work at only one hospital, or do they move around?
 - a. Scribes are usually matched to one hospital system. Experienced scribes have opportunities for advancement which may include multiple site work.
6. Are scribes compensated for training?
 - a. Yes, all training is compensated.
